Course in English (MA in English) affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad now coming under Rani Channamma University, Belagavi. Dr. (Mrs). S. V. Kupwade is the co-ordinator, The Department of Post Graduate Studies in English was started in Aug-2010 by S.K.E. Society's Rani Parvati Devi College of Arts & commerce with the intention that students of Belgaum and nearby areas could get quality higher education in English Literature and English language in Belgaum. The Post-Graduate Department of English of Rani Parvati Devi college of Arts & Commerce was inaugurated by the honourable Vice-Chancellor Prof. B.R. Ananthan, Rani Channamma University, Belgaum. The Post Graduate Department has 22 students who are studying for their post graduate degree in English. The Post Graduate Department which is recognized by the Govt of Karnataka, started with its affiliation to Karnataka University, Dharwad. Now it is affiliated to Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.



- **UGC sponsored add on course.**

University Grant Commission, New Delhi has sanctioned Certificate Course in Kannada for Non-Kannada students and students need to learn Kannada to mix and manage with local society, as Kannada is administrative language and official language of the state. It will help students in securing job opportunities. It also enhances the quality of day to day living and create and healthy atmosphere in the society. This add on certificate course is started from the academic year 2009-10.

There were totally 25 students sought the admission and emerged successfully with 9 students passed First class with Distinction. 8 students with Second class and 2 students with pass class. Dr. S. L. Kulkarni, Prof. (Mrs). K. K. Avadhani, Prof. H. B. Kolkar and Dr. (Mrs). S. P. Surebankar has served as counselor / teacher for the course. Dr. S. L. Kulkarni, Principal R. P. D. College, Belgaum is the Co-ordinator.

- **Certificate Course in Yoga Studies.**

R.P.D. College has introduced one year certificate course in Yoga Studies affiliated to Karnataka University Dharwad, now comes under the RCU, aiming to help the individuals to have their physical and mental health, emotional well-being and spiritual enlightenment. For this course, we have received the approval from Karnataka University Dharwad on 29-07-2009. We also have received the recognition from the Government of Karnataka on 14-07-2009. Admission for the course started from 01.08.2009. This year 55 students are admitted to the course. Dr. S. K. Saidapur, the Vice-chancellor, Karnataka University, Dharwad has inaugurated the Yoga Practical and Kriya Hall on 16.07.2009. Yoga regular classes started from 01.09.2009. Two students of yoga course, namely Miss. Yogita Patil and Mr. Umesh C. Kumbar have participated in South Indian Schools and College Yoga Championship 2010 at Bangalore.



Mr. Umesh C. Kumbar received 1<sup>st</sup> Prize in the competition between the age of 16-20 and Miss Yogita Patil received 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize in the competition. Mrs. Arati Padasalagi, Yoga teachers has received Patanjali award from the same championship. Smt Shalini from Vivekanand Kendra Kanykumari visited the department on April 8, 2011 and addressed the students. Students of 2010-2011 batch have made a remarkable achievement in their examination, the result is 85% passing, of which four students got distinction, twenty students got second class the remaining got pass class.

### **IGNOU, STUDY CENTRE, BELGAUM (1308)**

IGNOU Study Center (1308) was launched at R.P.D.College Belgaum in 1991. It is just completing 20 years. During these 20 years, the centre has made remarkable achievements in the field of education through distance mode. It has provided opportunities for over 7000 learners to acquire University certificates on various certificate, diploma, degree, and postgraduate programs. Through this University certificates the IGNOU learners have made their career progress, gained employment in various fields, and have got placement in their education fields. The study centre has a satisfaction for the services rendered to the public.

The study centre is reaching the information about various programs and activities of IGNOU to the learners of Belgaum district through counseling, news paper advertisement and brochures.

The students and interested public are visiting the study centre in connection with their academic field. The study centre is recognized as the noodle centre for conducting the examination of IGNOU on various programs. In the month of August 2010 and February 2011. more than 780 students have written their B.Ed, and MBA entrance examination.

However IGNOU study centre has conducted two Term End Examinations (theory and practical) in the months of July and December 2010. and more than 3400 and 3500 students have appeared for their examination on various courses. The student's strength is increasing on every session. In Jan 2011 session, 564 students have taken admission on various programs. More than 1600 assignments are submitted by the students for the July 2011 Term End Examination. In this session, the number of counselors on various courses is increased to 70. Teachers from many educational institutions in Belgaum are also associated with our study centre as faculty members for various programs. For the convenience the public the Principal of R.P.D. College and the



management members of S.K.E. Society have decided to shift the IGNOU Study Center's office to an another building of the Society, closer to the R.P.D. College entrance gate. In this new building the office is functioning between 5 and 8pm from Tuesday to Saturday, and on Sunday between 8am and 2pm, Monday being holiday.

During this academic year, some IGNOU authorities have visited the centre. Dr. Sanjaya Gupta. Asst Prof. Physics from SOS of IGNOU and Dr. Bagur S Prakash, Associate Prof of Economics of SOSS of IGNOU, New Delhi, have visited our centre for the IGNOU B.Ed and MBA entrance examination. On various occasions Dr. M .S. Parthasarathy has visited our centre to discuss the policies to improve the conditions of the centre. He also has permitted to activate MBA program at Gogte Institute of Engineering College Belgaum. Since our centre is a noodle centre in Belgaum. District, we also council the general public and the students for the programs which are not activated at our study centre.

### **HOBBY CENTRE REPORT-2010-11**

"Earn while we learn" has always been the motto of our Hobby Centre. This year, the main note worthy activity of the Hobby Centre was the one and half month (6 Sessions) Certificate Course in Personal Grooming in the month of August 2010.
