CERTIFICATE COURSE ON ORGANIC FARMING:

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

Organic farming is an integrated system of agricultural production based on ecological principles, promotion of biodiversity, biological cycles and organic matter recycling to maintain and improve soil fertility and environmental sustainability. The regulations for organic crop cultivation prohibit the use of chemo-synthetic pesticides, mineral fertilizers, growth promoters and Genetically Modified Organism. Indiscriminate use of these chemicals in conventional farming poses a serious threat to the quality of produce as well as the environment. Concern about food safety and security and environmental sustainability is increasing among scientist, administrator and environmentalist. In view of this, the course is designed to train students on organic farming practices, quality analysis of the products, environmental impact assessment, health benefit of the organic food etc. After successful completion of the course, the students should be able to design resource efficient farming system for small and marginal farmers for improving their economy while meeting the quality food demand in a sustainable environment.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

The main aims and objectives of the programme is to impart knowledge and proficiency in Organic production practices, Certification process and marketing of organically raised agricultural produces, promote self-employment and income generation.

- Discuss the scope and nature of organic farming in today's world.
- Select appropriate organic management systems for different organic farms.
- Understand the environmental, economic and political issues concerning organic farming.
- Explain the role of living organisms and decomposing organic matter in creating and maintaining an appropriate soil condition for successful organic farming.
- Contrive and apply appropriate weed management practices for an organic farm.
- Select and apply appropriate pest and disease management practices for both animal and plant production on an organic farm.
- Design an appropriate system for organic pasture management.

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Programme Duration:

Time Duration: 30 Hours (18 theory Classes + 12 practical Classes)

SYLLABUS:

Unit No 1: Introduction of farming, Importance of organic farming, Need and scope of organic farming. Transition from regular practice to organic farming practice, Estimated cost and time required for change over.

Unit No 2: Soil preparation - Soil nutrition and inputs enhancements, Study of microbial activities in soil.

Unit No 3: Crop selection as per region, Main crop/multi cropping pattern/ intercropping patterns, Importance of Rotation of crops, Study of crop schedule/duration. Seed selection, Seed treatment, Sowing patterns.

Unit No 4: Water management – Rain Water Harvesting. Irrigation-flood irrigation /drip/sprinklers. Fertigation, pest control, growth promoters. The whole idea is Self-reliant and self-sustainable agriculture.

Unit No 5: Agnihotra Homa organic farming practices.

Unit No 6 : Preparing own inputs like Vermicompost, Jeevamrut, Panchagavya, Bio fertilizer, etc. Weed management and control. Use of tools and equipments.

Unit No 7: Harvesting methods and post-harvest management. Marketing - direct marketing methods. Value addition.

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What The Course Covers

- Basics of organic farming
- Comparative study of cost of production between chemical and organic farming
- Economics and viability of organic farming and case study with different crops
- Government schemes and scheme on capacity building for organic products
- Documentation, Inspection and certification Procedure
- Basics of marketing, marketing channels and its functions for organic farming business.
- Practical shall include visit and study of grower group, certified organic farms.

CAREER PROSPECTS:

After completing this program, students may find work at plantations and farms indulged in organic farming. If you have enough resources at your disposal, you may even start your own organic farming venture, and students may also get involved in marketing of organic produce. In short, this program gives you access to regular jobs and self-employment opportunities.

1. To impart in-depth practical knowledge in organic farming.
2. To impart in-depth practical knowledge in crop cultivation practices.
3. To provide knowledge on working of different organic farm implements.
