6. To encourage the staff members to participate and present research papers in national seminars /conferences and workshops
7. To provide financial reimbursement in registration fees in presenting research papers in National/State level seminars, conferences and workshops
8. To provide seed money for two teachers to carryout minor research projects to society appointed staff in Arts, Commerce and BBA to the tune of Rs 5000/per year
9. To promote staff members to pursue PhD under Faculty Development Plan
10. Staff members are encouraged to arrange national/international seminars, workshops, Conferences and webinars both online and offline mode.
11. To provide information to the staff on research funding.
12. All faculty members are allowed to avail two special casual leave per term to present research papers.
