**POLICY ON GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS & SCHOLARSHIPS/ENDOWMENT  
FREESHIPS INSTITUTED BY INSTITUTIONAL EFFORTS**

The College has a variety of scholarships/freeships as well as endowment scholarships to be given to students of various categories classified on the basis of social and economic status. The scholarships/freeships available are identified by IQAC as follows:

Government scholarships/freeships/concessions:

1. Government of India SC scholarships/ Government of India ST scholarships
2. Backward Class Fee Concession/ Backward Class Post –Metric Scholarship
3. Backward Class Food and Accommodation Scheme (BCFAAS)
4. MHRD Scholarships
5. Govt. of Karnataka -Sanchi Honnamma GM –Girl Scholarships
6. Student Aid fund & Welfare Fund
7. Government of India Minority Scholarship
8. Government of India Physically Handicapped Scholarships

Scholarships/Freeships/concessions instituted or arranged through Institution's Own efforts:

1. Y.K. Prabhu memorial scholarship
2. Sitaram Jindal Foundation
3. Shivaji Foundation for Blind
4. Various endowment scholarships/prizes instituted over a period of time
5. RPD College Alumni Association scholarships/endowment


The IQAC believes that the scholarship/freeship/endowment facilities available should optimally be used, and for this the information should be adequately disseminated in time. The students should not only be informed to apply for various scholarships in time but also should be helped to apply. To ensure this the following mechanism needs to be put in place:

1. An office clerk with an internet enabled computer exclusively designated to look after the scholarship/freeships/endowments etc.
2. Issuing of proper notices for the students and ensuring rigorous circulation of the same. Uploading of necessary information on college website.
3. The college SC/ST committee to be involved in ensuring that the relevant scholarships are availed by the eligible students.
4. Formation of a scholarship committee to scrutinize and select the beneficiaries wherever it is required to be done at the college level (eg. Student aid fund/welfare fund etc.).
5. To keep a track of scholarships/freeships such as GOI minority scholarships, Physically handicapped scholarship which are directly credited to the students' bank account.
6. Formation of appropriate committees for the identification of beneficiaries for the scholarships/endowment instituted by the institution or arranged with its own efforts.
7. Helping the college alumni association by way of identifying and recommending the list of students who are eligible for the scholarships/endowment prizes instituted by it and as per its decided criteria.
8. At the end of each year submission of a set of documents pertaining all the scholarships/freeships consisting of sanction letter list of beneficiaries to IQAC for the purpose of NAAC documentation.

The IQAC should keep encouraging the institute to explore more scholarships/freeships available for students from Government as well as through Non-Governmental organizations.
