STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP POLICIES

Preamble:

Scholarships offer substantial financial relief covering tuition fees, books, accommodation and other educational expenses. By securing a scholarship, students can significantly reduce their financial burden, enabling them to focus more on their studies and personal growth

Our college facilitates the process to get scholarship to students under various governmental and non-governmental schemes like

1. State Govt. Scholarship

a. SC/ST student's scholarship

Eligibility

- The students must belong to SC/ST community group
- The student must be a domicile of Karnataka
- The must have Passed in previous year final exam
- The total family income should not exceed Rs 2.5 lakh.

b. Minority students scholarship

Eligibility

- The students must belong minority group (Muslim, Christain, Jain, Buddhist, Sikh, and Parsi)
- The student must be a domicile of Karnataka
- The must have scored at least 50 percent marks in previous year final exam
- The total family income should not exceed Rs 2.0 lakh.

c. OBC Student's scholarship

Eligibility

- The students must belong Other backward class group(Cat I, II A, IIB, IIIA, IIIB)
- The student must be a domicile of Karnataka
- The must have scored at least 50 percent marks in previous year final exam

- The total family income should not exceed Rs 2.5 lakh.

d. Sanchi Honnamma girl students scholarship

Eligibility

- The student must be a domicile of Karnataka
- The must have scored 60 percent and above marks in previous year final exam
- CBSC and the student studied outside the state is not eligible for this scholarship

2. Central Govt. Scholarship

a. MHRD Scholarship

Eligibility

- Students who have above 80 percentile of marks in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent and pursuing regular courses are eligible

b. Ex-serviceman central government Scholarship

Eligibility

- Son /daughters of Ex-servicemen who are studying in the institution are eligible
- The students must have Passed in previous year final exam.

3. Institutional Sponsored Scholarships

Our institution has instituted some scholarships to motivate and encourage the students who are outstanding in academics, co-curricular & extra-curricular activities, to help the students who are financially backward and to provide financial assistance to Divyangjan (differently abled) students.

3.1 Selection Committee

The scholarship selection committee matrix includes two senior faculty members, Student Welfare officer and Principal of the Institution.

3.2 Selection Procedure

All scholarship applications received shall be scrutinized based on defined criteria by the scholarship selection committee. The scholarship committee also has additional responsibility to explore available funds. An equitable distribution of scholarship is ensured by the committee based on merit cum means, not compromising on the competitive merit

and qualifications of the eligible candidate. The finalization of names is at the sole discretion of the committee members who take unbiased decisions. Students who are found ineligible for the award on various factors are not considered for the same. Award of scholarship also depends on availability of funds during that particular academic year.

3.3 Eligibility Criteria:

The eligibility to qualify for Institutional Scholarships varies on the nature of scholarship which could be merit, merit cum means, reservation and many more. The guidelines for eligibility as decided by the committee and approved by the Principal will be indicated clearly on the application form. While awarding the scholarship, several other indicators are also considered that may include previous academic scholarship award, excellence in extracurricular activities, and financial hardship of meritorious candidates as identified in the application form. All eligible students are required to submit the scholarship application form well within the stipulated time. The selection committee may request for additional information and documents as deemed appropriate. This may include scholarly activities of the applicant like participation in various activities which are pointers towards academic excellence. However recommendations by competent authorities may also be considered in a few deserving cases. It is the responsibility of the student to submit all documents along with application for consideration. Incomplete or inadequate information will render the application rejected.

3.4 Types of Institutional Scholarships

a. Y.K Prabhu scholarship for poor students

Eligibility

- The students must have Passed in previous year final exam,
- Needy and deserving students will be considered

b. Khatijabai Endowment scholarship for minority students

Eligibility

- The students must have passed in previous year final exam.
- The students must belong minority group.
- Needy and deserving students will be considered

c. M.L. Tukkar Endowment scholarship for outstanding Rural students

Eligibility

- Rural students are only eligible for this scholarship
- The students must have Passed in previous year final exam
- Needy , deserving and outstanding rural students will be considered

d. V. K. Saraf Endowment scholarship for Brahmin students

Eligibility

- The students must belong to Goud Saraswat Brahmin community group.
- The students must have Passed in previous year final exam
- Needy and deserving students will be considered

3.5 Award Notification:

The committee meets once the application formality is completed and scrutinizes the applications received in that particular academic year. The consideration may be based on merit, merit cum means, and eligibility as per the rules, special talents, sports and the like. The scholarship award clearly mentions the amount and type of scholarship. Students have to sign the scholarship acceptance letter before the last date. As a matter of policy the college awards only one scholarship in a year to a particular student. The awardee is communicated the same and is advised to go through the terms and conditions to avail the scholarship and sign the acceptance letter. The clause makes it clear that the facility may be withdrawn by the college at any time if the candidate is found ineligible for the same.
